Safety First @ Brookside!

We would like to remind all of our members that Brookside has many club rules, which our managers and guards will enforce throughout the season, so we can maintain safety and promote everyone's enjoyment at our swim club. Some of the important rules to keep in mind as the season begins are:

- ◆ No glass containers or bottles
- ◆ No running or horseplay
- ◆ Clean up your table/area when you leave, so that they next member(s) may enjoy it also
- ◆ No reserving tables, especially on special event days
- ◆ Children who use flotation devices (swimmies, etc.) MUST be directly supervised in the water

by a parent (including use of dive board). Direct supervision must also occur at all times at the baby pool, playground and while in the bathroom.

- ◆ Each driving lane in the parking lot is One Way. Upon entering our driveway, you must proceed straight ahead (one way) through the first lane (do not enter the parking lot and immediately turn left). Exiting must occur only through the two other lanes. Also, for everyone's safety, your speed should not exceed 5 MPH.

Thank you for following these very important rules so that everyone may stay safe and maximize their enjoyment of the club
